**Minutes of the State Primary Election
September 8, 2016**

The polls were declared open at 7:00 a.m. by Warden Mary Geromini. There were 0 voters standing in line to cast their ballots. Sample Ballots, Instructions to Voters, Voters Bill of Rights, and Zero Tabulations from Precinct 1, Precinct 2 and Precinct 3 were posted. The AutoMark handicap voting machine was turned on.

Town Clerk, Cynthia Thompson, welcomed and thanked the Election Workers, reviewed procedures and noted that there were four (4) different ballots for this election. All workers were sworn in and oaths were signed.

Reminders were given to poll workers that individuals enrolled in a party must take that particular ballot. Unenrolled voters and members of political designations may choose which ballot to receive.

Officers on duty were: Officer Peter Preston, Officer Derek Cassidy, Sergeant Jeffrey Smith and Sergeant Daniel Morris.

The ballot boxes were opened by Officer Preston with Warden Mary Geromini observing. The boxes proved to be empty and the zero tabulation was run and posted. The keys were handed over to Officer Preston and then to Officer Cassidy.

The turnout was quite slow with 51 voters having cast their ballots by 9:00 a.m. At the time of the Presidential Primary, there were 8,138 registered voters in Wrentham.

Forty (40) Absentee Ballots were processed by the Precinct Clerks during the day.

No voters used the Automark voting machine.

Turnout continued to be slow throughout the day.


Voters were confused with the Write-In Campaign between Shawn Dooley and Brian Hamlin for the Representative in General Court for the Democrat party. Overall, the day went smoothly.

At 8:00 p.m. Warden Geromini closed the polls. There were no voters waiting in line. The voting machines were programmed for tabulation and two sets of tapes were run. Tellers worked on reconciling their books and write-in votes were recorded. Results were completed by 9:30 p.m.

There were no provisional ballots, 5 spoiled ballots, and a total of 4 Affirmations. At 8:00 p.m. a total of 331 voters cast their ballots, or 4.0%.

All materials were returned to Town Hall by 10:00 p.m. Unofficial results were sent to the local newspapers for a story on Write-Ins. Official results were posted in Town Hall on Monday.

The Town Clerk would like to thank all the staff members who worked at this election to help make it a successful event.
